

**Rev. Chris Holdorf**  
**Senior Pastor, Oak Hill Baptist Church**

Since April 2011, Rev. Chris Holdorf has served as the Senior Pastor of the 1,500-member Oak Hill Baptist Church in Griffin, Georgia. Prior to coming to Oak Hill, Rev. Holdorf served as the Executive Assistant Pastor of First Redeemer Church in Cumming, GA. As one of the founding pastors of First Redeemer, Chris was instrumental in leading the church's growth from 90 people at its inception in 1996 to over 4,200 members today.



Prior to his calling into ministry in 1995, Chris served as a senior executive with several Fortune 100 companies and practiced as a Certified Public Accountant. Following graduate school at UGA, Chris joined Arthur Andersen & Co., an international public accounting and consulting firm. He later served as Vice President of Contel Corporation, Director of Taxes at GTE and Director of Taxes and International Business Development at Southern Electric International, a subsidiary of The Southern Company.

Chris hosts Power Lunch, a monthly business luncheon devoted to equipping business people to be “salt” and “light” in the marketplace. He is also the co-founder of [www.Headlineviews.com](http://www.Headlineviews.com), a web site committed to strengthening Christians’ Biblical worldview and understanding the Biblical truths behind today’s news headlines. Chris is a frequent speaker concerning leadership and character issues and he provides market-place consulting related to issues including strategy, visioning, servant leadership, and organizational issues.

Both Chris, and his wife Lynn, grew up in Dekalb County, Georgia and became high school sweethearts. They have been married for thirty years and have two children. Their son Christopher is the pastor of Morgan Baptist Church in Morgan, Georgia. Their daughter Emily is an interior designer in Charleston, South Carolina.
